



Shoots and Ladders Hat

Yarn used: worsted: [Bernat Satin](#)
(100 g/ 3.5 oz.) (color 04010-Camel)

Needles: size 8 circular – 16” and size 8 double-pointed

Cast on 88 stitches. This is worked in the round on a circular needle. When decreases make it difficult to knit, switch to double-pointed needles.

Join. Be careful to not twist stitches. Place a marker at beginning of row.

Row 1: knit across

Row 2: pearl across

Row 3: knit across

Row 4: pearl across

Row 5: knit across

Row 6-10: k4, p4 ribbing across

Row 11: * k4, p2tog, yo, p2, * repeat across

Row 12-16: k4, p4 ribbing across

Row 17: knit across

Row 18: pearl across

Row 19: knit across

Row 20: pearl across

Row 21: knit across

Row 22-26: k4, p4 ribbing across

Row 27: * k4, p2tog, yo, p2, * repeat across

Row 28-32: k4, p4 ribbing across

Row 33: knit across

Row 34: pearl across

Row 35: knit across

Row 36: pearl across

Row 37: knit across

Row 38-42: k4, p4 ribbing across

Row 43: * k4, p2tog, yo, p2, * repeat across

Row 44-48: k4, p4 ribbing across

Row 49: knit across

Row 50: pearl across – place a marker after every 8th stitch

Row 51: k2tog before every marker [77 stitches left]

Row 52: p2tog before every marker [66 stitches left]

Row 53: k2tog before every marker [55 stitches left]

Row 54: p2tog before every marker [44 stitches left] – it was on this row that I moved to double-pointed needles

Row 55: k2tog before every marker [33 stitches left]

Row 56: p2tog before every marker [22 stitches left]

Row 57: k2tog before every marker [11 stitches left]

Cut yarn. Draw the yarn through the remaining stitches. Tie off under hat.
