

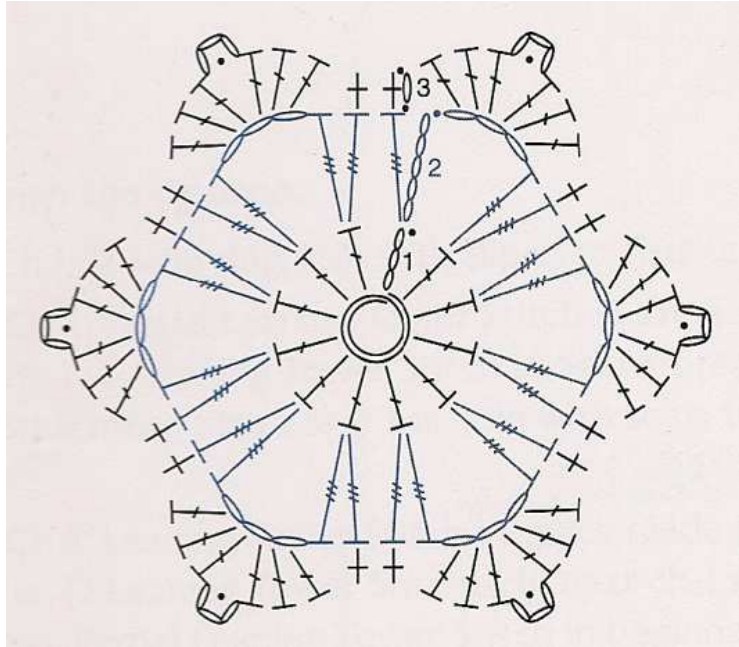

©2012 Autumn Crochet Shawl

**Crochet Hook:** 5.50MM

**Yarn:** Universal Yarn – Classic Shades – **Canyon** (Color 720 Lot 10/1504) – 4 Medium. This yarn is 70% acrylic and 30% wool.

**Pattern for Motif:**



Begin with a sliding loop.

**Rnd1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc). 11 dc in ring, join with a slip st to top of ch-3. (12 dc)

**Rnd 2:** Ch 5 (counts as dtr – see below motif instructions for more details on this stitch), dtr in same dc, 2 dtr in next dc, ch3, \*2 dtr in next 2 dc, ch3; repeat from \* four more times, join with a slip st to top of ch-5.

**Rnd 3:** Slip st in next tr, ch 1, sc in same stitch, sc in next dtr, skip 1 dtr, \*(3 dc, Picot-3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 space, skip 1 dtr, \*\* sc in next 2 dtr, skip 1 dtr; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*, join to first sc. Fasten off.

**dtr** (double treble crochet) – (yarn over) three times, insert hook into indicated stitch or space and pull up a loop, (yarn over, pull through two loops) four times.

### Pattern for Rosette:

Ch2, 6 sc in first chain, ch1, 2 sc in each chain around (12 sc); slip st to close and finish, leave long tail (6-8 inches – you'll use the tail to sew motifs together)

### Instructions for the Shawl:

1. Crochet 36 motifs. Block ([see directions I have posted for blocking motifs](#)).
2. Place motifs on a long flat surface – three motifs per row (or 4 motifs per row – you decide what you like best). Use stitch markers to gather the corners of the motifs together. Do this until all motifs are connected in a shawl layout.



3. Now you're reading to crochet the edging. This unites the motifs on the exterior edges.
  - Join yarn to corner. Ch 10, \* join at top of picot with sc, ch 1, sc 1, ch 10\* repeat between \* around entire group of motifs. Finish off.



4. Next make 44 rosettes. They will be used to unite the motifs together in the interior. Remove stitch marker; draw 3 corners together with the long tail on the rosette. Sew corners and rosette together evenly. Finish off neatly. Continue until the entire shawl is sewn together.



5. Wear or give as a gift.



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
